Selection of Consulting Services for Strengthening Of E-Government Infrastructure [March 9, 2022]

The Government of the Republic of Indonesia (GOI) has received a loan from the Economic Development Cooperation Fund (EDCF) towards the cost of Strengthening of E-Government Infrastructure and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments for the consulting service for Strengthening of E-Government Infrastructure which this invitation to bid is issued.

The Directorate of Government Informatics Applications Services, as the employer of the Consultant (the Employer), now invites eligible consulting organizations (limited to Korean Companies in Joint Operation with Indonesian Companies) to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultant should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualification and relevant experience to perform the services, i.e. firm's profile (including shareholder structure and description of similar projects, name of client, type of services provided and brief description of the services, name and location of projects, period of contract, starting date and completion date). The shortlisting criteria are firms' qualification and relevant experience in related field of services to be provided during last ten years. Experience in similar (i) Data center construction supervision consultant or (ii) IT consultant and/or construction supervision consultant will be preferred.

The Korean Companies are hereby requested to fully utilize the Indonesian Companies' resources and expertise of the works under similar condition and to effectively promote the transfer of technology to Indonesian Companies as a Joint Operation. The Employer intends to initially select a maximum of 5 (five) firms. It is expected that invitations for bid will be made in March 9, 2022 until May 11, 2022.

As preliminary information, the following is a brief scope of this work package :

The Republic of Indonesia has the fourth Medium-Term National Development Plan (RPJMN 2020-2024) which serves as a framework for the medium term (five year) development.

Under the main sector of development dimension, (i) Strengthen economic resilience for growth quality, (ii) Developing regions to reduce gaps and ensure equal distribution, (iii) Increase resources human power that is quality and helpless competitiveness, (iv) Build culture and national character (v) Strengthening infrastructure to support economic development and basic services (vi) Building environment life, improve disaster and resilience climate change, and (vii) Strengthening stability of politics and law and public service transformation. In the RPJMN 2020 – 2024 there are 7 development agendas.

Among the seven agendas, Strengthening Infrastructure to Support Economic and Basic Services Development were established to accelerate the digital transformation. While Strengthening the Stability of Political, Legal, and Security Affairs; and Transformation of Public Services were established to promote the national bureaucratic reform. As a detailed plan for this, the Indonesian government aims to facilitate all economic, government and national education sector activities through improving the information and communication technology (ICT) network, and secure competitiveness by providing e-government systems and services in all regions by 2025.

The Ministry of Communications and Informatics (KOMINFO) developed this project as a core a-government infrastructure in order to integrate individual a-government systems and functions from each government agency into one standardized and structured system, which will lead to significantly improve the ICT, cyber security related capabilities and administrative service qualities. To support the GOI's efforts to ensure that high-priority projects are implemented efficiently by advancing preparatory activities in a systematic manner through consulting services for the National Data Center (NDC) for Strengthening of E-Government Infrastructure.

The consulting services (the Consultant) will assist the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) National Data Centre (NDC) under the Directorate of Government Informatics Application, Directorate General of Informatics Application, Ministry of Communication and Information, The Government of Republic of Indonesia. The services will include in two fields, namely Architecture and Information and Communication Technologies (ICT). There are several tasks on both fields: (a) Review the basic design done by GOI consultants, (b) bidding support, (c) NDC construction supervision, (d) ICT equipment selection and technical specifications & quantities confirmation. The period of these services is 55 (fifty-five) months. The estimated cost for the consulting services is \$ 6,578,000 – (Six Million Five Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Dollars).
